

PRIVACY POLICY

New Northwest Broadcasters (NNB) and its family of stations respect your privacy. This Privacy Statement outlines the information NNB will collect and how that information will be used. This Statement will also instruct you on what to do if you do not want your personal information collected.

Information Collection

Browsing this or any NNB radio station site is done anonymously. NNB will not collect your name, address, telephone number, or e-mail address unless you provide it voluntarily. However, we may attempt to collect such information if we believe your use of this website violates any laws. If you do not want this information collected, please do not submit it to us.

When you do provide us with personal information, we may use that information in the following ways, unless otherwise stated: we may store and process that information to better understand your needs and how we can improve our services. We may also use that information to contact you. However, we will not provide that information to third parties.

Usage by Children
